ADGA Goat Registration/Membership

If you have a goat to be registered, you first must pick a name. All names start with Herd Name, which is from the person who bred the goat. Each goat gets assigned a tattoo number, which comes from the farm where the goat was born. The total number of spaces for the name is 30, including Herd Name and any spaces.

If you are a member of ADGA, you will need your ADGA membership number for the Transfer of Ownership.

If you need to join ADGA, you can do that either before or after the goat is registered. ADGA offers on line or mail in forms. Their website is: www.adga.org.

If this is your first time joining, you will also need to send in a Herd Name Application, on line or mail in. As well as a Tattoo Application, mail in. If you want to set up on line access, you will need to mail in a PIN application after you have your ADGA membership number.

You will need the Herd Name and Tattoo if you plan on breeding.

Under General Forms you will see a form call Schedule or Rates (SOR). That will show the all the current ADGA prices.

You will find all these ADGA forms on www.adga.org, click on Forms on the top menu bar and scroll down to Membership Forms. Of course there are lots of other information there! The membership will get you started.
